Calumet Specialty Products Partners, L.P. (Calumet) respectfully requests resolution approval of project numbers: 20161561, 20161562, 20170091, 20170160, 20170161, 20170190, 20170191, and 20170192 filed with the Louisiana Economic Development (LED) under the Louisiana Industrial Tax Exemption Program.
